# DOCUMENTATION NEEDED:

- Birth Certification
- Verification of address and citizenship
- · Valid drivers license or passport
- · Verification of income and resources

# WHO QUALIFIES FOR COVERAGE?

- A United States citizen or meet Medicaid non-citizen requirements
- Individuals with low-income
- Nursing home and institutional care residents
- Those qualifying for home and community based waiver services
- Individuals with disabilities or who are legally blind
- Pregnant women, infants, and children up to 18
- Applicants between age 19 and 64
- · Adults 65 years of age or older

# WHO IS ELGIBLE FOR MEDICAID IN OHIO?

To be eligible for coverage, you must:

- Be a United States citizen or meet Medicaid citizenship requirements. Your local county Job and Family Services office can help to explain these requirements and can help get you enrolled.
- Have or get a Social Security number.
- Be an Ohio resident.
- Meet financial requirements. Even if you are not sure that you or your family will qualify for coverage, you should still apply.

 Non-U.S. citizens may be eligible for Alien Emergency Medical Assistance or Refugee Medical Assistance.
